

COMMUNITY SERVICE WORK CREW RULES

- 1. I will report to the steps of the Geauga County Courthouse, at 100 Short Court St., facing Chardon Square, at 8:00AM. My transportation will be at the Common Pleas Courthouse parking lot at 4:00PM. I understand that if my transportation does not arrive by 4:15PM, I will be escorted to the Chardon Police Department located at 111 Water St., Chardon, Ohio, (non-emergency telephone number is 440 (286- 6123) where I will await my transportation to arrive. Summer weekday workcrew clients will report to the lobby of the Juvenile Court by 8:00AM.**
- 2. I will wear the proper clothing to and from the Work Crew and throughout the day while on the Work Crew. This includes: longs pants or shorts appropriate in length, long or short sleeved T-shirt, and work boots or shoes. I will not wear open toed shoes or flip-flops.**
- 3. I will bring a lunch and something to drink throughout the course of the day, as I am fully aware that the Work Crew van DOES NOT make stops to purchase food or drink.**
- 4. I will apprise the Crew Supervisor and or Community Service Coordinator of any medical or physical limitations or conditions that I have PRIOR to beginning the work day.**
- 5. I understand that the use and possession of cellular phones, blackberries, portable audio players (walkman/CD players, hand held TVs and I Pods) and other paging devices during the work day is STRICTLY prohibited. I will submit these devices to the Crew Supervisor when I arrive at the Courthouse. I understand that these items will be kept in the Crew van glove box and that cellular phone use is only permitted in case of emergency or to coordinate transportation at the end of the work day.**
- 6. I will submit to security screenings administered by the Crew Supervisor using a hand held metal detector at any time during the work day. I will empty my pockets without question if instructed to do so by the Crew Supervisor or any other adult authority**
- 7. I will not smoke or bring any smoking related items, to the Work Crew. This includes tobacco products, matches, lighters, or related paraphernalia; any and all will be confiscated by the Crew Supervisor and forfeited if found on my person.**
- 8. I will not bring or have on my person any drugs, legal or illegal. I will turn in any necessary prescription medications that I might need during the day to the Crew Supervisor upon arrival at the Courthouse.**
- 9. I will not back talk, use vulgar language, or raise my voice in any manner that is not appropriate. I will not be rude or ignorant to any of my peers, supervisors or others in the public I encounter during the work day.**
