## **2013 Residential Code of Ohio (RCO)** **Energy Compliance Declaration Form**

### **2013 Residential Code of Ohio 1101.2 Compliance.**

Compliance shall be demonstrated by meeting the requirements of *one of the following options*:

1. The "International Energy Conservation Code"; (IECC) or
2. 2013 RCO Sections 1101 through 1104, Prescriptive Method; or
3. 2013 RCO Section 1105 – "The Ohio Home Builder's Association (OHBA) Alternative Energy Code Option" (OHBA not available for additions & alterations).

### **Applicant shall indicate the energy compliance option below:**

**2009 International Energy Conservation Code (IECC)**

- REScheck based on the 2009 IECC
- Prescriptive method based on 2009 IECC Table 402.1.1
- Prescriptive method based on U- Factor alternative 2009 IECC 402.1.3
- Prescriptive method based on Total UA alternative 2009 IECC 402.1.4
- Simulated performance alternative 2009 IECC 405

- Testing option per 402.4.2.1 (blower door)
- Visual inspection option per 402.4.2.2 (third party inspection)

- Testing option per 1102.4.2.1 (blower door)
- Visual inspection option per 1102.4.2.2 (third party inspection)

- Compliance Path #2

\* Air leakage testing (blower door) will take effect January 1, 2014

\* Duct tightness testing will take effect January 1, 2014
